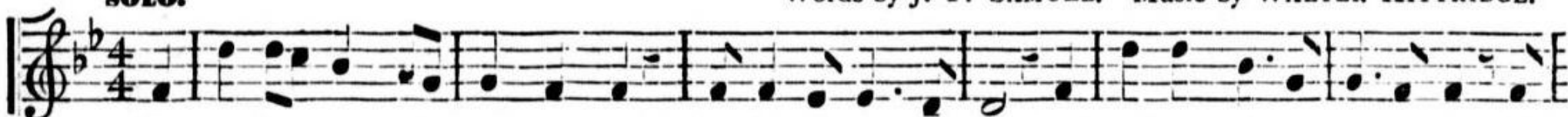

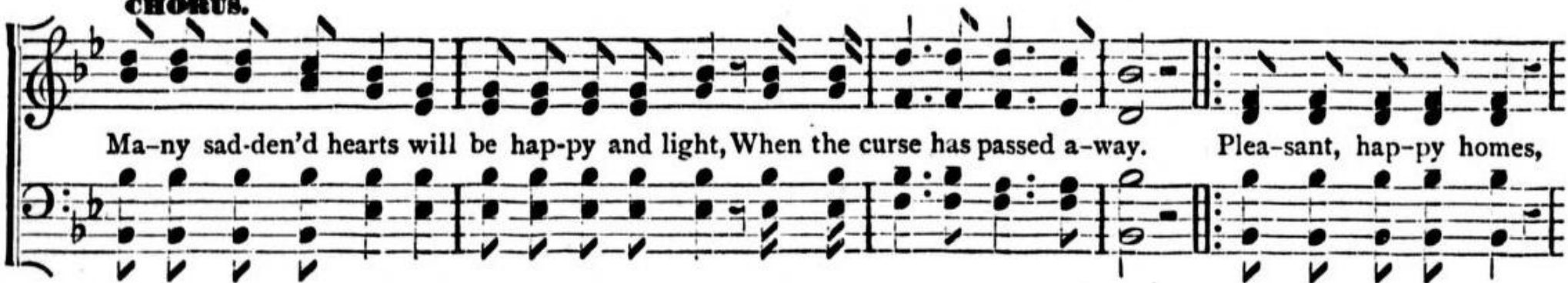
1. The Temp'rance ju - bi - lee draws near, The day of joy and peace; Let ev-'ry heart ex - ult and sing, For
