Chord suggestions for the first staff: G D G Am C G Em Am D

Chord suggestions for the second staff: G D G Am C G G D G D G

Chord suggestions for the third staff: D D7 G Em G D Am D G D G

Chord suggestions for the fourth staff: Am C G G D G C G G C G

You only have to play/hear a few notes to figure out how this hornpipe got its name. The first bar is the same as the old song "Pop Goes The Weasel". (Although that is usually thought of as being in 6/8) After that it's a completely different tune. Although not written out in a "dotted" rhythm it may have been played more as a clog than it might seem from the music.
